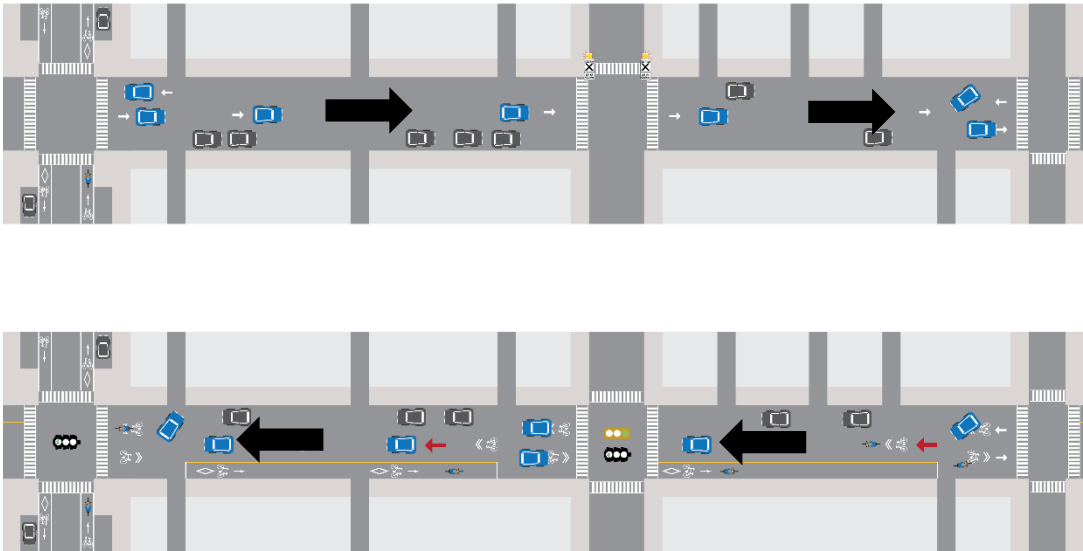
Installation of Road Safety Improvements and Bikeways on
Palmerston Avenue - College Street to Robinson Street

Start Date: July 12, *Rain date July 13, 2022 (weather permitting)

The City of Toronto is preparing to install contra-flow bike lanes, protected cycle tracks and other safety improvements including wayfinding markings on Palmerston Avenue, Palmerston Square, Palmerston Boulevard and Tecumseth Street from Dupont Street to Niagara Street. The project was approved by the Infrastructure and Environment Committee in December 2021. **The City is currently installing the College Street to Robinson Street segment, including a contra-flow bike lane on the west side of Palmerston Avenue.**

During installation, the City’s contractors will complete the following work:

- Remove existing pavement markings;
- Install applicable pavement markings to flip the street northbound and install a contra-flow bike lane; and,
- Install new signage, as required.



Please park as usual during the installation. The morning after installation, the vehicular direction of Palmerston Avenue between the laneway south of College Street and Robinson Street will be flipped northbound. If parked on these blocks, please exit Palmerston Avenue northbound by doing a 3-point turn to turn around on July 12 (rain date July 13).

	Parking and Loading: During the installation, please park on the east side facing south as usual. After the installation of the contra-flow bike lane, the vehicular travel direction will be flipped northbound and you will park on the east side facing north. Vehicles illegally parked on the west side or in No Parking zones during the installation will be relocated to a nearby location. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.
